Step 1: Site Visit

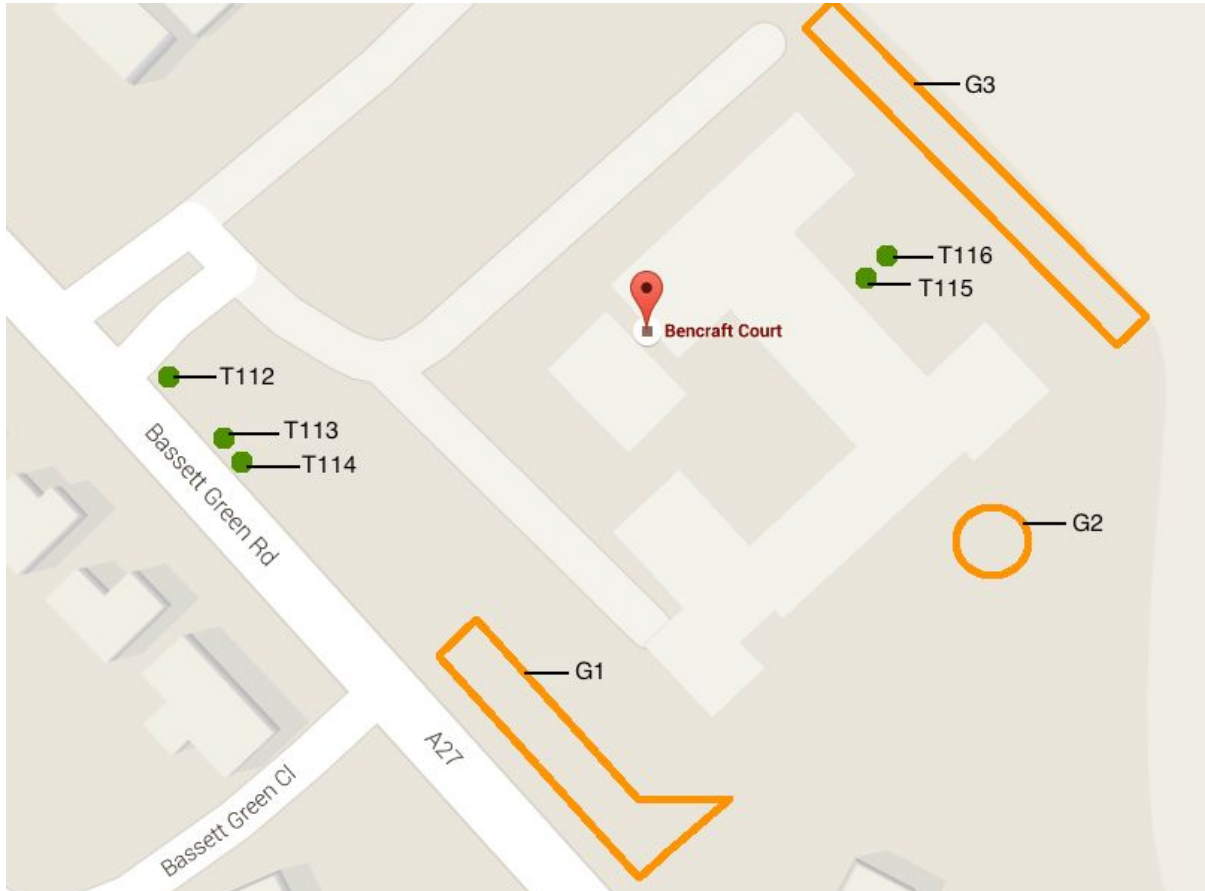
(The maintenance plan will be carried out by a member of staff who holds level 3 qualifications within arboriculture along with professional indemnity insurance)





Step 2: Aerial Image of the Site


An image will be produced of the site. Findings from the site visit will be plotted and identified in groups or individual trees, for example G1 would stand for Group 1, and T1 would stand for Tree 1, and so on and so forth.





Step 3: Grounds Maintenance Schedule

A spreadsheet will be produced listing all necessary details to maintain the grounds to a high standard within the time frame outlined on the sheet.
